CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

1. Dust control material may be applied by an approved contractor for the resident, at the resident's expense. A **TWO WEEK NOTICE** is required prior to application of dust control material, so that the roadbed may be prepared. The two week period begins on the date that the notification is received by the Franklin County Engineer's Office. First application of dust control will not be applied in Franklin County until mid-May to allow roads to adjust to spring weather conditions.
2. The only materials approved for use on Franklin County roads are calcium chloride, magnesium chloride, and lignin sulfonate.
3. If Franklin County is notified by a contractor of any additional subsequent application of dust control material following the first application, the road will be bladed prior to subsequent application. A two week notice is required prior to any subsequent application for preparation of the roadway.
4. Franklin County reserves the right to re-work the treated area and maintain it as loose granular surface if the County Engineer or designee feels there is a safety hazard to the traveling public.
5. Dust controlled areas will be bladed through on or about the second week in October to prepare roads for the winter.

CLEARLY FLAG THE AREA. FLAGS ARE TO REMAIN IN PLACE THE ENTIRE DUST CONTROL SEASON.
